Usher

Task

- 1. Ushers meet attendees at the back of the sanctuary, pass out bulletins, and direct attendees as they arrive to where they would want to sit (as necessary).
 - i) Treat first time visitors as guests of God, not strangers.
 - ii) Look people in the eye and smile.
 - iii) Take the initiative, don't wait for visitors to initiate conversation with you.
- 2. Remind attendees of current Covid protocols at they enter.
- 3. Ushers pass plates for the offering collection and direct attendees for communion.
- 4. Be alert for any attendees needing assistance or appearing distressed and assist as able.
- 5. After service, go back through the church and pick up any trash or left behind items.

Impact

- 1. Your service will provide Advent with a warm, smiling, welcoming face at the door as guests arrive.
- 2. Your service will show the congregation the hospitality of welcome as they enter for services and events.
- 3. Your service will create a welcoming atmosphere, especially for those who are not familiar with Advent.

Timeframe

- 1. Your service lasts for a term of one calendar year, from January 1 to December 31.
- 2. Service hours vary, depending on service or event, usually 15 minutes prior to the service or event and a few minutes afterward.
- 3. A schedule is arranged with prior sign-ups, with volunteer shifts for Sundays per calendar month and special services and events as they occur.
