Congregation Council Member

Task

- Duties include but are not limited to the directives as outlined in the Constitution for Advent Evangelical Lutheran Church. Council oversees the "business" of the congregation.
- In addition to duties listed in the Advent Constitution and in layman's terms, council members duties include:
 - Serving as a member of the Church Council and work toward what is best for the congregation
 - o Being familiar with and upholding the governing documents of the congregation
 - Attending all Church Council and Congregational meetings to oversee and provide administration
 - Being involved in at least one standing committee and act as liaison between the Church Council and that committee reporting on that committee's activities to the Council
 - Participating in Church functions such as: community events, soup suppers, and social events
 - Being available to listen to anyone in the Congregation or community as a representative of Congregation leadership
 - o Ensuring that the decisions of the Council are carried out

Impact

- 1. Your service will provide Advent Lutheran Church with responsible leadership and governance.
- 2. Your service will show the congregation that appropriate business actions are being taken on their behalf.
- 3. Your service will create a sense of transparency regarding the operation of the Council and the business of Advent Lutheran Church.

Timeframe

The position is for a 3 year term, renewable once. Service begins at installment following the January Congregational meeting and election. Service hours vary, usually between 2 and 10 hours per month. The Council may vote to temporarily fill a vacancy occurring on the Council until the next regular Council election, as provided for in the Constitution.
