# Advent Lutheran Church Volunteer Service Description

## **Synod Assembly Representative**

#### Task

- 1. Synod Assembly representatives represent Advent at the annual Rocky Mountain Synod Assembly by:
  - i) Reviewing Assembly materials sent out for background in advance of the Assembly
  - ii) Gathering input from the pastor, council, and members regarding any items to be voted on during the assembly to form an informed opinion on the issue

- 2. Traveling to the Assembly location, being present and participating in the Assembly as Advent's lay representative.
- 3. Providing a brief summary report of the Assembly and your personal observations to the pastor, council and congregation in a timely fashion after the assembly.

#### **Impact**

- 1. Your service will provide Advent with representation for Rocky Mountain Synod business.
- 2. Your service will show the congregation that Advent is involved with leadership of the synod.
- 3. Your service will create a stronger connection between Advent and synod leadership.

### **Timeframe**

1. Your service lasts for a term of one calendar year, from January 1, 202x to December 31, 202x+1. Service is usually three days during the assembly, usually during spring, plus a few hours of prep and report writing. The assembly may be held outside the metro-Denver area, with transportation and lodging provided by Advent. Term may be renewed upon agreement between the team coordinator and volunteer.

The Synod Assembly reps report directly to the pastor.
