Evangelism, Empowerment, Excitement Team, (Triple-E Team) Member

Task

The Triple-E Team (Evangelism, Empowerment, Excitement Team) provides opportunities for connecting with the community around Advent by envisioning, organizing, and conducting activities for the congregation which invite the nearby community to participate. The Team focus is to promote Evangelism, generate Excitement, and Empower the congregation to support the Mission of Advent. To accomplish this, the Team members:

- i) Meet once monthly to plan activities that will engage the congregation and neighbors.
- ii) Organize, promote, and staff special events in which members and neighbors are encouraged to participate, such as the Neighborhood Festival.
- iii) Coordinate and staff companion activities such as receptions for established events like Christmas eve or Easter services.

Impact

1. Your service will provide Advent with outreach opportunities to show our neighbors how we spread God's love.
2. Your service will show the congregation that we are working in the world to spread the message of God's love.
3. Your service will create opportunities to engage the neighborhood so that they see what Advent does.

Timeframe

1. Service lasts for a term of one calendar year, from January 1 to December 31. Service hours vary, depending on activities and events planned, usually less than 4 hours per month. Term may be renewed upon agreement between the team coordinator and volunteer.
